District 12 Coach Pitch League Softball Rules 2023

- 1. No manager, coach, player, or fan shall at any time, whether from the bench, the playing field or elsewhere incite, or try to incite, by word or sign, a demonstration by spectators; use language which will in any manner refer to or reflect upon opposing players, manager, coach, an umpire, or spectators
- 2. No arguing calls. All judgment calls are final. Questions regarding interpretations should involve team managers only. Remember- our goal is to get the call right.
- 3. Games start at 5:30 pm (unless agreed upon by both teams).
- 4. Weekday games: New inning cannot be started after 90 minutes or dusk.
- 5. Weekend games: Maximum length of a weekend game is 2 hours. New inning cannot be started 1 1/2 hours after the first pitch.
- 6. A player can only sit out 2 defensive innings per game. Players should be moved to different positions during each game. Players should not be designated a position for the entire game. All players should be allowed to play all positions during the course of the season.
- 7. 3-5-9 rule. Each half inning will end at 3 outs or 5 runs- whichever comes first.
- 8. Continuous batting order, open defensive substitution.
- 9. Stealing- There is no stealing in this division.
- 10. Children should be taught to lead off the base once the pitched ball has reached the catcher.
- 11. Base Advancement. If a player gets a clean hit that reaches the outfield that player may advance as normal at her own risk of being put out.
- 12. There is no advancement of the runner on an error. Players are still developing their throwing and catching skills.
- 13. No infield fly rule in effect. No head first sliding.
- 14. Pitching----The coach should not throw more than 6-7 good pitches to a child. If they do not hit the ball, they will be declared out and the next batter will hit.
